The Public Appointments Secretariat of the Province of Ontario issued official Order-in-Councils in May appointing Aileen Ashman and Glenn Rogers to the Central East Local Health Integration Network (Central East LHIN) Board of Directors each for a three-year term.

Ms. Ashman, an Oshawa resident, started her professional career as a frontline nurse in general duty in British Columbia and Ontario, including significant experience in critical care units and emergency departments. Later she moved into a hospital administration supervisory role in British Columbia, before returning to Ontario to take on fulltime studies at law school.

A member in good standing with the Law Society of Upper Canada, Ms. Ashman has extensive experience in labour relations, working for the Ontario Nurses Association, the Durham District School Board, the Simcoe County District School Board, Orillia Soldiers' Memorial Hospital, Toronto Police Service, and most recently York University where she was the Assistant Vice-President, Human Resources, before retiring in 2015.

Mr. Rogers, a Peterborough resident, is a longtime community volunteer and retiree from IBM Canada with 37 years of service in a variety of Canadian and North American Sales and Marketing roles. Mr. Rogers recently completed a seven year term with the Board of the Central East Community Care Access Centre (CECCAC), where he served in a variety of roles including Vice Chair, Chair of the CECCAC Governance Committee, developing and implementing a workplan on Board and committee evaluations and as a member of the CECCAC's Performance, Quality and Effectiveness Committee.

A past Corporate Member of the Peterborough Regional Health Centre, Mr. Rogers is currently a member of the Peterborough Council on Aging (PCOA) and Co-Chair of the PCOA Marketing Committee.

- The role of the LHIN Board of Directors is to oversee, advise on and govern the strategic direction and priorities of the LHIN.
- Directors are appointed by Order-In-Council for a term of one to three years, and may be appointed for one further term.
- The Chair and the Directors are appointed based on their expertise, experience, leadership skills and the needs of the LHIN and are accountable, through the Chair, to the Minister of Health and Long-Term Care for the LHIN's use of public funds and for its results in the local health system.
