



### **Judicial Review – Final Decision Statement from the Central East LHIN Issued August 25, 2008**

#### **STATEMENT**

The Central East LHIN is pleased by the ruling by the Divisional Court of the Ontario Superior Court of Justice that has dismissed an application for judicial review brought by the Ontario Public Service Employees Union.

The decision, released on Friday, August 22<sup>nd</sup> and available on the Central East LHIN website, is the first judicial comment on the Local Health System Integration Act, 2006 and provides clarification of the roles and responsibilities of the LHIN.

The board and staff of the Central East LHIN look forward to continuing to work with community residents, front line health care staff and health care organizations in improving and strengthening the public health care system through the implementation of priorities identified in the Integrated Health Service Plan.
